The *Teaching Winery* is the only fully licensed teaching winery in Canada with a focus on preparing students for work in the "real" world. The *Teaching Brewery* is the first fully licensed teaching brewery in Canada. Tastings are available for a small fee but are not required to participate in the tour.
